PROPOSAL TO AUTHORIZE NEW MILLAGE TO PAY COSTS AND EXPENSES ASSOCIATED WITH ENFORCEMENT OF TOWNSHIP AMPLIFIED NOISE ORDINANCE AND OTHER ORDINANCES

Shall the Township of Hamlin impose an increase of up to 0.50 mill (\$0.50 per \$1,000 of taxable value) in the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution and levy it for 6 years, 2024 through 2029, inclusive, to generate new revenue to pay the costs and expenses associated with equipping, contracting for, retaining, and/or employing one or more law enforcement officers or ordinance enforcement officials to enforce the Hamlin Township Amplified



Noise Ordinance and other township ordinances, which 0.50-mill increase would generate an estimated \$153,853 in the first year the millage is levied?
This millage, if approved, would authorize a new additional millage, and all revenue raised by this millage would be disbursed to the Township of Hamlin.
