A Time for Choosing...

"Freedom is never more than one generation away from extinction. We didn't pass it to our children in the bloodstream. It must be fought for, protected, and handed on for them to do the same, or one day we will spend our sunset years telling our children and our children's children what it was once like in the United States where men were free." by Ronald Reagan, October 27, 1964.

In 1964, Ronald Reagan was engaged in public speaking events and was asked by the Republican Party to air a speech for the 1964 Presidential campaign. Watching what was occurring within our great nation at the time, Mr. Reagan thought it paramount to alert Americans about the value of freedom. His speech, titled, "A Time for Choosing," also known as the "Freedom Speech," sought to unify the American people around the shared common goal of pursuing freedom, which he emphasized wasn't a guarantee.
