Additions to the Agenda: Susan asked everyone to introduce themselves and tell a little about who they are. Much interest in hearing about the election issues. There were no communications and no public comments.

Reports from Delegates attending the State Convention. Cindy Muzzo, Tim Muldoon and Jeff Crawford shared their experiences with the Feb 6 Virtual State Convention to elect State Party Positions. All agreed that it was chaotic, disorganized and there were some technical difficulties. Cindy announced that the Supreme Court would be hearing election fraud evidence on February 19th. Also Tim Muldoon handed out several documents covering the election fraud evidence. Operation Guard the Vote summary regarding the post election review in Wayne County of 51,000 previously registered voters. Many volunteers spent countless hours to uncover many anomalies. In another handout there were listed 35 questions to pose before certifying the 2020 election. We still don't have answers to these questions.

Reports from elected officials:

Senator Curt VanderWall updated us on his activities in the Senate and in the Committees he is part of. He has been working diligently on the Covid Vaccine oversight Committee. Also discussed the Election Reform Oversight Committee activities. There were many questions for him on these topics.

County Commision Chair Janet Anderson was absent but asked us to read her update provided by email.

Representative Huizenga and Representative O'Malley were unable to join us for this meeting and we did not receive any updates from them.

Sheriff Cole is unable to be here so Derrek Wilson provided a report for the Sheriff's Department.

Clerk Cheryl Kelly reported that her office is always very busy. She answered some questions regarding elections processed in our county being very secure. The Secretary of State in Michigan has made the process more difficult for the clerks.
